**MOUNT DESERT ISLAND REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL  
USE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS**

The Mount Desert Island Regional High School Board recognizes that medical emergencies may arise on school property that warrant the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED). The school unit has an AED for use by authorized personnel. The Superintendent is responsible for implementing the AED program and all necessary administrative procedures. The Superintendent may delegate specific responsibilities concerning the AED program to administrators, including the Health Services Director, as he/she deems appropriate.

Although the Board authorizes the acquisition of AEDs, it cannot and does not guarantee that an AED or a person trained in its use will be available at any particular school site or school-sponsored event.
